General Information

Our mission is to offer a developmentally appropriate educational experience for toddlers and early childhood-aged children in a weekday church school setting.

Learning activities are provided in a nurturing Christian atmosphere that encourages the spiritual, physical, mental, social and emotional development of your child.

We strive to be available to church families and the community at large, and to provide enrichment for those families and their children.

We provide a professional staff under the auspices of the appropriate governing bodies of First Presbyterian Church of Fort Worth.

The Day School is accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), reflecting our commitment to the latest research and best practices in early childhood education and development.

Our program is open to toddlers (18 months old by September 1) through 5-year-olds. Classes meet from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, depending on the age group and class. New this year is a five-day-a-week class for 4-year-olds.

We also offer a Bridge program for children who will be 5 years of age by September 1. This program meets Monday-Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.



How To Register

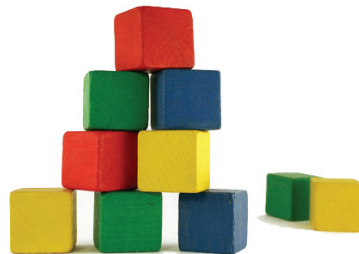
Pre-Registration is for:

If you are eligible for pre-registration, please complete the registration form, attach the enrollment fee and return the form to the box outside the Day School office no later than 12:30 p.m. on Friday, January 27. *Please note:* To pre-register, families must be current in their financial obligations to the Day School and Childcare Center.

Registration is for the general community. Registration will be open to the community on Monday, February 6, by mail-in registration. All forms must be postmarked no sooner than February 6 and no later than February 29.

In the event of lack of space in any class, registration materials will be processed in the order listed above, and priority given in the order that materials have been received.
